Kullu are Rohtang Pass, Solang Valley, Vashist hot water springs, Great Himalayan National Park, Manikaran, Kasol, Bijli Mahadev Temple etc.

How to Reach Manali (Haripur):

By Road: There are many direct buses plying to Manali from Delhi, Chandigarh, Shimla and other cities of HP.

BY AIR: Kullu (Bhuntar) is the nearest airport (flights are not frequent) and Chandigarh (the nearest airport) where frequent flights from all-over India being operated.
